2. The data we collect about you

We may collect, use, store and transfer different kinds of personal data about you as follows:

- **Identity Data** includes first name, maiden name, last name, username or similar identifier, the company you work for, job title and date of birth.
- **Contact Data** includes billing address, delivery address, email address and telephone numbers.
- **Financial Data** includes bank account and payment card details.
- **Transaction Data** includes details about payments to and from you and other details of products you have purchased from us.
- **Technical Data** includes internet protocol (IP) address, your login data, browser type and version, time zone setting and location, browser plug-in types and versions, operating system and platform, and other technology on the devices you use to access this website.
- **Usage Data** includes information about how you use our website, products and services.
- **Marketing and Communications Data** includes your preferences in receiving marketing from us and our third parties and your communication preferences.

We use different methods to collect data about you. We collect data from when you engage with us in one of three ways via our Website:

- Your communication with us via our online chat service.
- Your communication with us via our contact us form.
- Your request to be added to our newsletter or updates.

If you email us using any of the contact details on our Website, we will handle your data in accordance with our own established systems and not necessarily in line with this website privacy notice. This is because this contact is outside the scope of our Website privacy notice.

6. International transfers

We may transfer, store and process your personal data outside the UK. However, where we do so it will only be for purposes where it is necessary.
